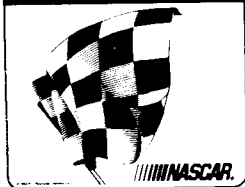

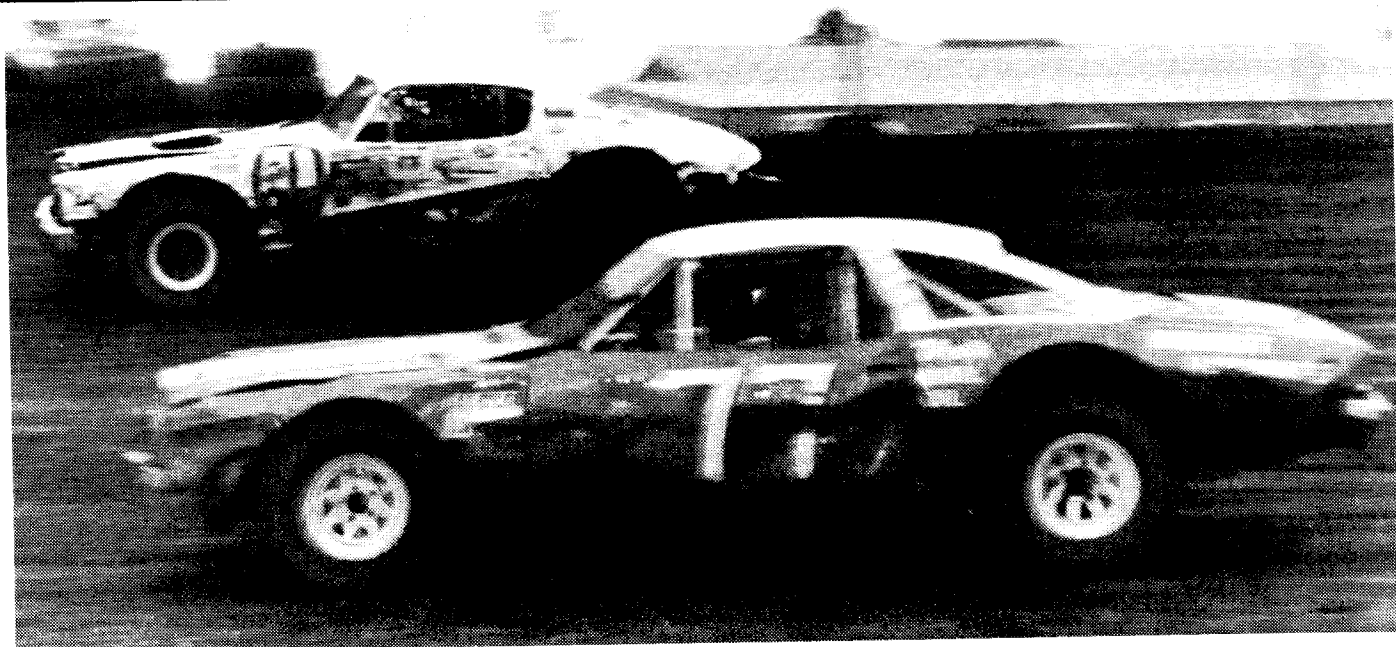

Thoennes captures first main win

successfully defended his Modified Division title.

Tonight will find a 50-lap late model feature which will be split up and counted as a double feature race. Tonight's race program is sponsored by Gatorade.

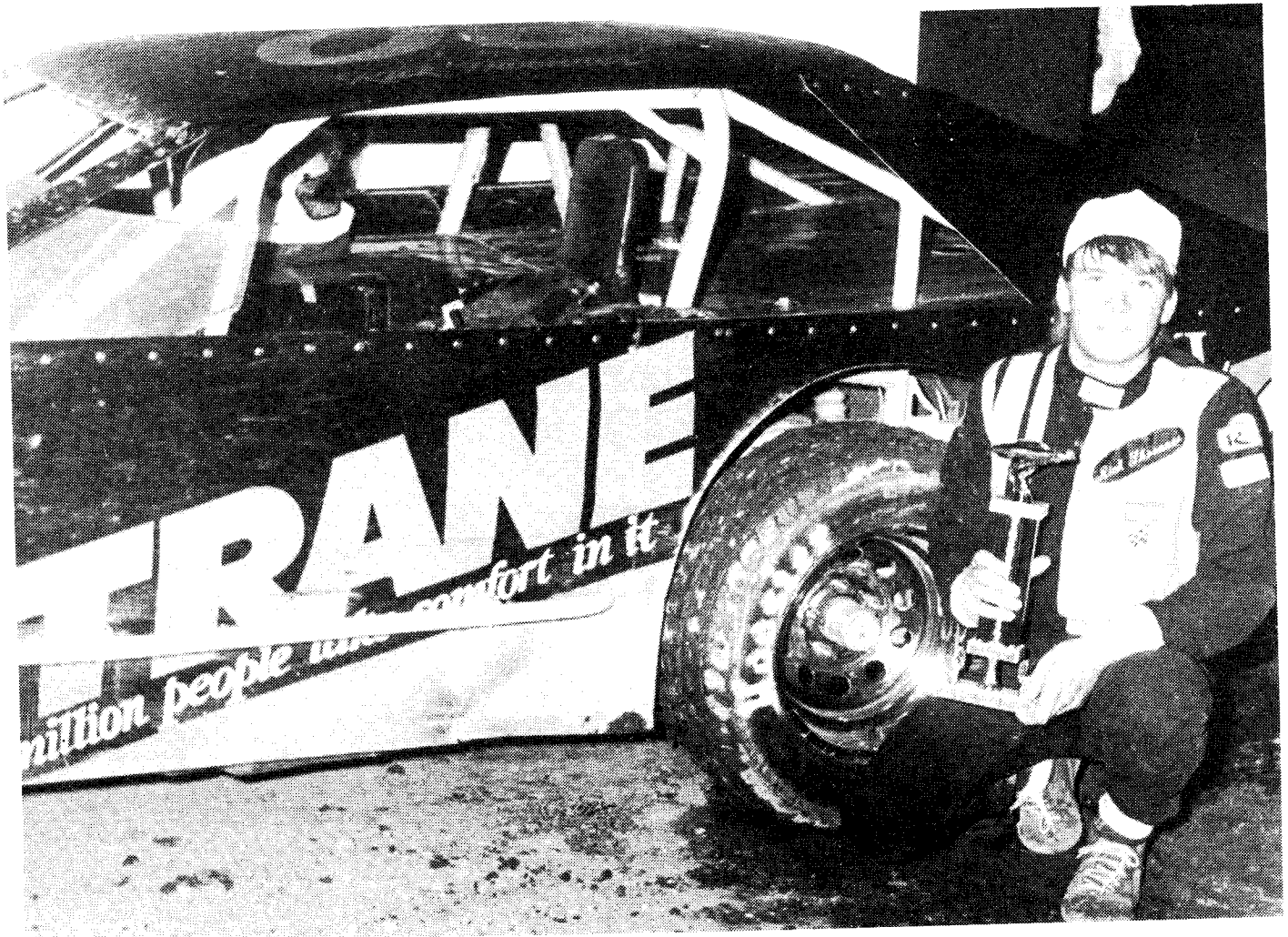
Next weekend will close out the 1992 season with racing scheduled for both Saturday and Sunday night;s.



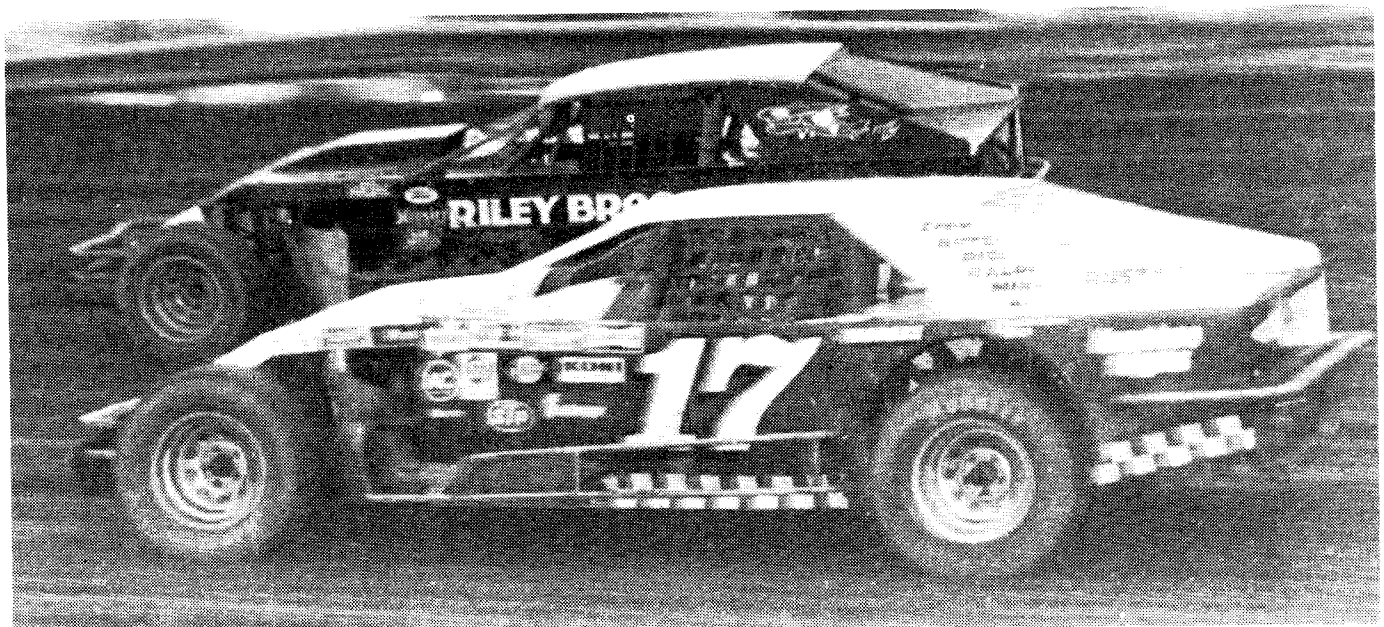

Welcome race fans to Viking Speedway



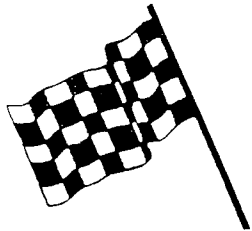

Brian Rust (17) battled wheel to wheel with Dave Storck (57) coming out of turn four last Saturday night during one of the NASCAR Modified heat races.



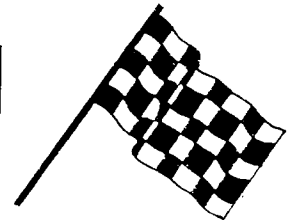
Brian Rust received the Steinbring Bonus Dash check from Dean Plaster following his win in that event here last Saturday night.
